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IV. <u>Finance – Technology</u>

<u>Project Description:</u> In FY 2021, The City created an account for the Citywide property revaluation project and upgrade to Vision Appraisal system in the amount of \$900,000. The City reval and upgrade contract to Vision came in less than expected. The City is looking to transfer the anticipated balance of \$250,000 from the reval account to the City IT account and City rolling stock account.

The transfer of \$125,000 will enable to City to upgrade the fleet of pool cars for City staff.

The Transfer of \$125,000 will enable IT to continue to enhance and maintain the City's technology infrastructure including network, software, and equipment.
