

**NEW HAVEN CITY PLAN COMMISSION ADVISORY REPORT**

**RE:** **ORDER OF THE BOARD OF ALDERS** establishing a residential parking zone on Portsea Street. (Alder Evelyn Rodriguez)

**REPORT: 1548-14**

**ADVICE:** Additional Clarification Required

**BACKGROUND**

City ordinance requires any party requesting the establishment of a Residential Parking Zone (RPZ) to demonstrate that over 50% of residents on specific blocks are in favor of establishment. Alder Evelyn Rodriguez of the 4<sup>th</sup> ward has submitted an order to establish such a zone on Portsea Street. She has also attached a petition which includes signatures from 23 residents.

**PLANNING CONSIDERATIONS**

While RPZs are allowed under City ordinances to be established, this petition needs to provide clarification of which blocks of Portsea Street a RPZ is requested. It also needs to include an accounting of residents per block as well as the number of signatures received per block. City Plan staff recommends these clarifications be made prior to final submission to the Board.

**ADVICE**

The Commission recommends the Board accept the application upon clarification.
