ORDER OF THE BOARD OF ALDERS Establishing a Residential Parking Zone to include both sides of the block of Concord Street from Burr Street to Elmer Street. (Alder Salvatore DeCola)

REPORT: 1557-11 ADVICE: Approval

BACKGROUND

The residents in the area submitted a petition to the Board of Alders to establish a residential street parking zone on both sides of the block of Concord Street from Burr Street to Elmer Street in order to address a shortage of on-street parking for residents in a densely populated residential area.

PLANNING CONSIDERATIONS

The establishment of a residential parking zone on Concord Street from Burr Street to Elmer Street complies with the City's Comprehensive Plan:

New Haven Vision 2025, Section I-10: "Maximize the assets and infrastructure with respect to the availability of parking on city streets."

City ordinance requires any party requesting the establishment of a Residential Parking Zone (RPZ) to demonstrate that over 50% of residents on specific blocks are in favor of establishment. Alder DeCola has attached a petition which includes signatures from 13 residents along the Concord Street, demonstrating compliance with this requirement.

ADVICE

The Commission finds the Order in the best interest of the City and recommends approval.
