## BACKGROUND

87 Union Street: The applicant seeks to secure a time extension to allow for the completion of a mixed-use development consisting of the construction of 299 rental units, 206 parking spaces, retail space, amenities, and a swimming pool at 87 Union Avenue. On February 18, 2015, the City Plan Commission granted Site Plan approval for the mixed-use project that requires that construction be completed by February 18, 2020. The applicant has indicated that construction was delayed due to two appeals of City approvals for the project that were not resolved until the fall of 2016. The project is not yet complete, and the applicant has requested that the Site Plan approval for 87 Union Street (CPC Report 1502-03) be extended from February 18, 2020 to February 18, 2025.

## FINDINGS AND ADVICE

Based on the above information and in accordance with Connecticut General Statute § 8-3, the Commission approves the five-year extension of time of the Site Plan and Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Plan approval for 87 Union Street (CPC Report 1502-03) until February 18, 2025.
