

DIRECTIONS

To reach DPPW Office from downtown New Haven, take I-91 North to Exit 5 and merge onto State St. Follow State under I-91. At third light, take right Ferry St. and cross bridge over rail tracks. At light, take left onto Middletown Avenue. The **DPPW** office, 34 Middletown, is up on your left just past the light.

Residential drop off is at **260 Middletown Avenue**, **New Haven**, **CT 06513**. Take left out of DPPW Office parking lot and continue down Middletown Ave for .07 miles. As Middletown curves towards I-91 there is a road to the left. Veer left and road leads into the entrance of the **Transfer Station** and residential drop off services.

Bulk Drop-Off

New Haven residents can use the free coupons they pick up at DPPW office to access the services at the Transfer Station. Valid coupons must be presented along with matching ID.

Coupon Book allows you to drop off:

- 1. Yard Waste trees, branches, leaves only
- 2. Bulk Waste 4 tires, metal, electronics, textiles, toys, etc.

Tires are yearly, NOT each visit

Drop-Off Without Coupons

Recycling

You can drop off all items that are accepted in New Haven's curbside recycling pick ups. Recycling containers are lined up on the left hand side near Transfer Station.

Construction/Demolition items

Materials such as woods, fencings, roof shingles, sheetrock, masonry, toilets, tubs, sinks, etc. can be brought to the scale house were there is a charge of \$0.05 per pound.

Materials Not Accepted

Hazardous Waste

Household hazardous waste must be taken to Haz-waste Central located at the Regional Water Authority, 90 Sargent Drive. Haz-waste is open Saturday mornings from May until October, excluding holiday weekends. Info: 203-401-2712

Transfer Station offers a fee for service to contractors and trash haulers. For more information please contact the office of the New Haven Solid Waste and Recycling Authority at 203-691-5374.

BULK TRASH

Bulk Pick Up

Residents must call the DPPW office at 203-946-7700 to schedule an appointment for Bulk Trash Pick Up. There is a \$50.00 fee for Bulk Appointments. The first bulk appointment is free if you are the homeowner of a house with one to three units. If not the first appointment is \$50.00. All residents must pay \$50.00 for the second bulk appointment in the same calendar year. We only accept check, money, or exact cash (we do not provide change). All checks must be made payable to Treasurer City of New Haven.

Bulk Pick Up Guidelines

To make your pick up easy and efficient the following guidelines must be followed.

Failure to follow guidelines will result in a \$250.00 fine daily.

1. Place bulk trash at curb no earlier than 24 hours before appointment.

2. Place metal items in a separate pile. Do not place with other bulk items

3. Place trash so it is accessible by a pay loader, not blocked by cars, trees or signs.

4. Don't block sidewalks, roadways or fire hydrants.

5. No yard waste such as grass, branches or leaves.

6. No construction or demolition debris in bulk pile including wood, roof shingles, sheet rock, masonry, plumbing fixtures and fencing.

7. Don't place household hazardous waste in bulk pile including paint cans, aerosol spray cans, etc.

8. Don't place recyclables with bulk

9. Bulk pile must not weigh more than 750 pounds or the resident will be charged for the extra amount.

10. All appliances must have their doors taken off before being left for pick up at curb.

Transfer Station

If you would like to utilize the **Residential Waste Center** to drop off your items you can either have items weighed and pay the cost or pick up free coupons at DPW office. In order to receive coupons, you must show a CT driver's license, city or state id with a current New Haven address on it. The coupon book includes 4 Yard Waste coupons and 4 Residential Waste coupons valid for one year.

The coupons are redeemable at the Transfer Station where an attendant is on duty to accept them. Recycling bins are also located near the Transfer Station.
