

TRAFFIC AUTHORITY AGENDA

Representatives of the Department of Traffic and Parking will present the following items to the Traffic Authority of the City of New Haven on May 10th, 2022.

Item 1. Request of Kampton Singh, Alder, Ward 5, for establishing TWO HOUR PARKING 8AM-7PM, MONDAY-SATURDAY regulation of the north side of Lambertson Street from Arthur Street to Dewitt Street and on the south side from Plymouth Street to Greenwich Avenue. Approval recommended.

Item 2. Request of Kampton Singh, Alder, Ward 5, for establishing NO PARKING regulation of the south side of Lambertson Street from Greenwich Avenue to Kimberly Avenue. Approval recommended.

Item 3. Request of the Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking for parking controls in areas less than one block in length as indicated below be approved.

- 12. In front of 103 Maltby Street..... 2 spaces
- 13. In front of 71 Pierpont Street..... 1 space
- 14. In front of 193 Wolcott Street..... 1 space

B. Rescind RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED parking spaces.

- 1. In front of 52 Fulton Street..... 1 space

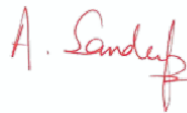
Approval of A. and B. is recommended.
