BACKGROUND

The New Haven Board of Education (BOE) proposes to construct the Strong21st Century Communications Magnet and SCSU Lab School on land owned by the Board of Regents (BOR) for Higher Education on property currently forming a part of the campus operated by Southern Connecticut State University. The Strong School is a New Haven Public School serving children in grades K through 4. In order to construct and operate the Strong School at the Property, it is necessary that the City enters into a lease of the property from the BOR for and on behalf of the BOE.

PLANNING CONSIDERATIONS

The site plan for the proposed Strong School at 69 Farnham Avenue was submitted to the City Plan Commission and approved on May 17, 2017 (CPC item 1530-07). This lease would allow that approved project to take place.
