## BACKGROUND

The State of Connecticut Department of Transportation has made the Highway Safety grant available to local jurisdictions. New Haven is eligible to apply for up to \$3,000.00 for equipment. The New Haven Police Department is requesting \$3,000.00 to purchase a computer, stop sign holder, work lights, tint meters, HG pens for sobriety checks, and a tent for inclement weather. These will facilitate planning, promote good traffic management, aid investigations, and improve working conditions at the checkpoints which creates a safer experience for drivers, pedestrians, and officers.

## PLANNING CONSIDERATIONS

The grant would fund equipment that would help improve traffic safety in the city. This grant has no apparent conflicts with City land use policies.
