

## NEW HAVEN CITY PLAN COMMISSION ADVISORY REPORT

**RE:** **ORDER OF THE BOARD OF ALDERS** Establishing a residential parking zone on Porter Street between Judson Avenue and Parmelee Avenue. (Residents of Porter Street)

**REPORT:** 1532-10

**ADVICE:** Approval

### BACKGROUND

There are 14 homes on the block of Porter Street between Judson Avenue and Parmelee Avenue. Occupants of 12 of these homes have submitted a petition requesting that this block be turned into a residential parking zone (RPZ).

### PLANNING CONSIDERATIONS

The affected street is a residential street in the West River neighborhood two blocks east of Ella Grasso Boulevard. There are no commercial uses or parking limitations in the vicinity that would either increase demand or restrict supply of available spaces. However, the Transportation, Traffic, and Parking (TTP) Department's threshold for granting an RPZ is 50 percent of residents must request one. In this case the threshold has been met.

### ADVICE

The Commission finds the Order in the best interest of the City and recommends approval.
