## **BACKGROUND**

The City is submitting an application to the South Central Regional Council of Governments (SCRCOG) for the painting of the Chapel Street Bridge. Under Local Transportation Capital Improvement Program (LOTCIP), the City is responsible for creating the design (\$54,000), while LOTCIP covers 100 percent of the construction costs (\$2,945,000).

## PLANNING CONSIDERATIONS

The bridge is in need of an abrasive blast cleaning and field painting of the structural system to preserve the structure. The total cost of the project including the design, inspection, and construction phases is estimated at \$3,000,000. The Bridge is eligible for FY2017 LOTCIP, which allows for 100 percent funding.

## ADVICE

The Commission finds the Order in the best interest of the City and recommends approval.
