RE: Submitting an order authorizing the Mayor to sign an agreement with South Central Connecticut Regional Water Authority (SCCRWA) for the replacement of water facilities due to the construction of the replacement of the Brookside avenue bridge. (From the Acting City Engineer)

BACKGROUND

Before the Board is an order authorizing Mayor Harp to enter into an Agreement between the City and the South Central Connecticut Regional Water Authority (SCCRWA) for the water facility replacement in conjunction with the construction of the replacement of the Brookside Avenue bridge. Submitted by Acting Town Engineer, Larry Smith. This bridge is currently under repair and needs to install a 12" water main line on the fascia of the new bridge. The Brookside Avenue bridge is in poor condition and is limited in load capacity. This agreement between the City and SCCRWA is needed to allow construction of the new bridge with all the associated inspection and construction fees for the water lines. This is a capital project and 32.85% of the cost will be reimbursed to the City of New Haven by the State of Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) under a grant for the "State Local Bridge Program".


The City agrees to:

- The cost of the structure carrying the 12" water main over the Wintergreen Brook Bridge is not included in this cost estimate. The City contract will pay for and construct the structure, while the RWA will furnish and install the water main on the structure
- The temporary utility bridge will be designed and constructed by the City's contractor to carry the 6" temporary water main. The City contract will pay for and construct the temporary utility bridge, while the RWA will furnish and install the water main on the bridge. The cost of the temporary utility bridge is not included in this estimate. The estimated cost is \$202,724.21.

ADVICE

The Commission finds the Agreement in the best interest of the City and recommends approval.
