## BACKGROUND

The property is currently a vacant lot owned by the City of New Haven. It is to be sold to Habitat for Humanity for construction of an owner-occupied, single-family house subject to a 5-year owner-occupancy requirement.

## PLANNING CONSIDERATIONS

The dimensions of the corner lot are  $\pm 75$  feet wide and 87.5 feet deep. This is considered to be a conforming lot. Compliance with the RM-2 zoning regulations for yard setbacks, height limits and required parking, and the dimensions of any related zoning relief, can only be determined at the time when a specific construction proposal is submitted.
