- Item 1. Request of Charles Decker, Alder, Ward 9, for establishing RESIDENTIAL PARKING regulation on both sides of Mill River Street from State Street to Dead End. Approval recommended.
- Item 2. Request of the Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking, for establishing TRAFFIC SIGNAL control of the intersection of Edgewood Avenue and Winthrop Avenue. Approval recommended.
- Item 3. Request of Evette Hamilton, Alder, Ward 24, for establishing ALL WAY STOP control of the intersection of Edgewood Avenue and Ellsworth Avenue. Approval recommended.
- Item 4. Request of the Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking for parking controls in areas less than one block in length as indicated below be approved.

A. Establish RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED parking spaces.


- 1. In front of 322 Blatchley Avenue..... 1 space

- 6. In front of 604 Winthrop Avenue..... 1 space

B. Rescind RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED parking spaces.

- 1. In front of 58 Bishop Street..... 1 space
- 2. In front of 61 Bishop Street..... 1 space
