

TRAFFIC AUTHORITY MINUTES
OCTOBER, 2022

The Traffic Authority of the City of New Haven, duly noticed, met via teleconference, New Haven, Connecticut, on October 11th, 2022.

The meeting was called to order at 6:02 PM, Commissioner Ribeiro presiding.

The Agenda of the Traffic Authority was moved for approval by Commissioner Walker and seconded by Commissioner Miranda. The motion was voted on and approved unanimously.

The Minutes of the September 13th Traffic Authority Meeting were moved for approval by Commissioner Walker and seconded by Commissioner Miranda. The motion was voted on and approved unanimously.

The following items were presented:

Item 1. Request of the Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking, for establishing NO TURN ON RED regulation of specific approaches to various intersections. Approval recommended.

Bruce Fischer presented the technical report. Commissioner Walker moved to approve the item. Commissioner Lawlor seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and approved by a unanimous vote.

Item 2. Request of Jay P Inzitari, RMS Companies for temporary traffic control change to ONE WAY eastbound traffic flow on Lafayette Street from Washington Avenue to Church Street South required during construction of the Lafayette Street Residential Project. Approval recommended.

Bruce Fischer presented the technical report. Commissioner Miranda moved to approve the item. Commissioner Lawlor seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and approved by a unanimous vote.

Item 3. Request of Eli Sabin, Alder, Ward 7 for establishing a westbound counterflow BIKE LANE on Audubon Street from State Street to Orange Street. Approval recommended.

Bruce Fischer presented the technical report. Commissioner Brooks moved to approve the item. Commissioner Miranda seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and approved by a unanimous vote.

Item 4. Request of the Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking for parking controls in areas less than one block in length as indicated below be approved.

A. Establish RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED parking spaces.

- 1. In front of 160 Canal Street..... 1 space
- 2. In front of 65 Carmel Street 1 space
- 3. In front of 22 Harding Place..... 1 space
- 4. In front of 574 Howard Avenue..... 1 space
- 5. In front of 173 Pine Street..... 1 space


- 6. In front of 31 Ridge Street..... 1 space
- 7. In front of 103 Sherman Avenue..... 2 spaces
