Summer Camp Descriptions 2023

Below you will find a brief description of each camp. This year, we will have certified teachers at each camp. They will provide educational sessions in the morning from 9:30 am – 11:30 am. Breakfast & Lunch will be provided at most sites except for: ALL Light House sites, Eco Trowbridge, and Eco West Rock. All recreational activities will take place from 12pm – 3pm. Please check individual camp schedules for changes. Dress Comfortable clothing - shorts or pants, t-shirt and sneakers are mandatory. For Safety: No open toed shoes are permitted (flip-flops, Crocs, sandals, etc.) Sunscreen, insect repellant and water shoes are recommended. Your child should bring a bathing suit, swim cap and towel to camp every day.

Trowbridge is very similar to our regular city camps with an outdoor component. Those activities will include hiking, canoeing and other environmental and educational activities.

EASY BREEZY CAMP @ Beecher School for ages 5 - 10

Camp Easy Breezy is a summer camp for children with asthma and siblings. Campers will do the same camp activities as other summer camps and will go on field trips. What makes this camp special is that a registered nurse will be on-site during all normal camp hours and on field trips. Additionally, while at Camp Easy Breezy, campers will learn how to use your asthma medications, identify their asthma triggers, and learn how to better control their asthma while having FUN with FRIENDS.

To participate in Camp Easy Breezy, campers must live in New Haven. This camp if for children ages five to ten. Camp Easy Breezy, is a six-week long camp. Campers must register for all six weeks.

Please note: A registered nurse will not be on-site for before and after care programs. A registered nurse will only be on-site from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. The nurse will go with campers on all field trips.

ECO ADVENTURE CAMP
