PROPOSED SITE PLAN MODIFICATIONS

The proposed additional work at 18 Tower Lane in New Haven, CT involves the conversion of existing hardscape south of the building into a new garden and gathering space as well as small layout changes near the building drop-off and accessible parking area. Construction is anticipated to start in Summer 2023 with a duration of about 12 months.

Site work associated with the proposed garden includes new planted areas, garden beds, a recirculating fountain stream, concrete paver gathering areas, benches, a pergola, and a concrete bocce court. The proposed work results in a decrease of about 0.22 acres of impervious area which is a decrease of about 29% within the limit of disturbance and 1.9% over the entire site. Pervious areas will be planted with lawn, mulch beds, or plant beds.

COASTAL SITE PLAN REVIEW

Proposed minor modifications are exempt from Coastal Site Plan Review per NHZO Section 55(f)(3) which includes an exemption for "Construction of new or modification of existing on-premise fences, walls, pedestrian walks and terraces, underground utility connections, essential electric, gas, telephone, water and sewer service lines, business signs under 30 feet in height and such other minor structures as will not substantially alter the natural character of coastal resources or restrict access along the public waterfront"

SITE PLAN REVIEW

Plans have been reviewed by the Site Plan Review team with representatives from the Departments of City Plan, City Engineer, Building, Disabilities Services and Transportation, Traffic and Parking and have been found to meet the requirements of City ordinances, regulations, and standard details.
