## Summer Camp Descriptions 2024

Below you will find a brief description of each camp. Breakfast & Lunch will be provided at most sites except for: ALL Light House sites, and Eco Trowbridge. Most camps will participate in some type of STEM activity. Please check individual camp schedules for changes. Dress in comfortable clothing - shorts or pants, a T-shirt and sneakers are mandatory. For Safety: **No open-toed shoes are permitted (flip-flops, Crocs, sandals, etc.)** Sunscreen, insect repellent and water shoes are recommended. Your child should bring a refillable water bottle, bathing suit, swim cap and towel to camp every day.

**TINY TOT CAMPS (ages 5 – 7):** these camps are specifically dedicated to our younger campers. They will be able to participate in age-appropriate sports and activities that will include field trips, hiking, arts and crafts, swimming and going to area playgrounds/splash pads.

**ECO ADVENTURE CAMP and CAMP CORAL**

***New Haven Residents \$125 per session Non-Residents \$260 per session Extended Day: \$50 for extended day per session***

These camps offer a unique, challenging, and fun combination of outdoor adventure and environmental education. Participants must bring lunch and two liters of water per day. Increased challenges will provide high energy adventures that may include canoeing, team building, introduction to kayaking, snorkeling, rock climbing, hiking, swimming, and more.

**Liability Release and Parental Consent Form**

This release is intended to discharge in advance the City of New Haven, the New Haven Board of Education, their officials, officers, employees, volunteers, and agents from liability, even though that liability may arise out of perceived negligence on the part of persons mentioned above. It is understood that some recreational activities involve an element of risk or danger of accidents, and knowing those risks, I hereby assume those risks. It is further understood and agreed that this waiver, release, and assumption of risk is to be binding on my heirs and assignees.

I hereby attest that I have been informed of the following pertaining to the coronavirus:

People who are 65 years and older and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions or are at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19 are recommended to stay at home. A list of medical conditions associated with a higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19 can be found in CDC's guidance. Individuals and families should consult their healthcare provider to determine whether they have medical conditions that place them at risk.
