## Summary from Members Carter, Fawcett, Rivera-Berrios:

After reviewing this case we had a few documents we would like to review if they could be made available to us:

-Past discipline for Patrol for the officer involved in this case along with shift times of incidents (requested to Lt Agosto) - not received as of 6/24/2024

-Past discipline for IA for the officer involved in this case along with shift times for incident (requested to Lt Agosto) - not received as of 6/24/2024

-Overtime log for this officer for a 3 month period proceeding the incident (requested to Lt Agosto) - not received as of 6/24/2024

**Recommendations:** 

-Review overtime log to determine if that could have impacted the officers performance -Review shift times during disciplines to see if it could have impacted the officers performance

-Ensure that all officers are trained on protocols when called to incidents at MTA, bus station, colleges, Universities, police or substations,

-Provide a lengthy de-escalation training for this officer

-send the officer for a mental health assessment if it has not had one in the last year (pre-5 year assessment) to ensure that no further supports are needed

-assign a mentor to this officer for a 6 month to one year period for monthly check ins -Provide training to all officers when working with homeless population
