Individuals, businesses, neighborhoods or civic groups can select a nearby hydrant to adopt and care for!



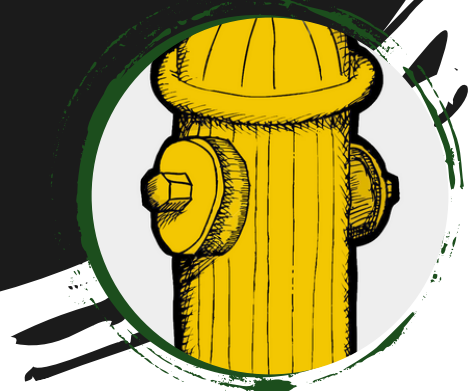
SNOW & ICE REMOVAL

- CLEAR WIDE ENOUGH PERIMETER AROUND HYDRANT (3FT)
- CLEAR A PATH TO THE STREET



TRIM TALL GRASS & VEGETATION

- UPKEEP WITH LAWN MOWING & WEED WACKING
- CLEAR WIDE ENOUGH AREA AROUND HYDRANT (3FT)
- CLEAR A PATH TO THE STREET



ADOPT & CARE FOR HYDRANT

- REPORT DAMAGES OR WATER LEAKS
- GET YOUR FAMILY INVOLVED, YOUR NEIGHBORS OR ENJOY SOLO!
- PLEASE DO NOT PAINT THREADS OR OPERATING NUT ON TOP OF HYDRANT
