- Item 1. Request of Carmen Rodriguez, Alder, Ward 6 for establishing RESIDENTIAL PARKING regulation on both sides of Washington Avenue from Liberty Street to Lafayette Street and for establishing RESIDENTIAL PARKING regulation on the south side of Prince Street from Lafayette Street to Gold Street. Approval recommended.

- Item 2. Request of the Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking for establishing BIKE LANES on the street segments listed herein. Approval recommended.

- Item 3. Request of Frank Redente, Alder, Ward 15 for establishing NO STANDING regulation of the east side of Clinton Avenue from Chatham Street to Grafton Street. Approval recommended.

- Item 4. Request of the Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking for parking controls in areas less than one block in length as indicated below. Approval recommended.

A. Establish RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED parking spaces.


- 1. In front of 63 Admiral Street..... 1 space
