We began the month with 39 animals in the shelter (31 dogs and 8 cats).

43 animals were taken into the shelter (30 dogs, 13 cats).

16 animals were redeemed by their owners.

20 animals were adopted as pets (including 8 that were transferred as adopted pets).

7 Euthanized (2 sick cats at Central and 5 dogs for temperament at shelter).
