

The City of New Haven Policy Notice of Non-Discrimination

The City of New Haven does not discriminate on the basis of Race, Age, Ancestry, Income, Color, National origin, Familial status, Marital status, Creed, Citizenship status, Religious creed, Sex, including pregnancy, Sexual Harassment, Transgender status, gender identity or expression, Sexual Orientation or civil union status, Veteran status, Criminal record, Genetic Information in administration of its programs or activities. The City of New Haven also does not intimidate or retaliate against any individual or group because they have exercised their rights to participate in actions protected, or oppose action prohibited, by 40 C.F.R. Parts 5 and 7, or for the purpose of interfering with such rights.
