

TRAFFIC AUTHORITY MINUTES
MAY, 2021

The Traffic Authority of the City of New Haven, duly warned, met in Chambers, One Union Avenue, New Haven, Connecticut on, May 11th 2021.

PRESENT (via Zoom): Commissioners: Evelise Ribeiro, President, Michael Lawlor, Tracey Meares and Donald Walker.
Douglas Hausladen, Bruce Fischer, Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking.

The meeting was called to order at 6:02 PM, Commissioner Ribeiro presiding.

The minutes of the April 13th, 2021 meeting were approved as amended.

Douglas Hausladen requested that Item 1 as presented on the original agenda be withdrawn due to a typographical error and the agenda be amended to include Item 1. below.

Commissioner Walker moved to approve the request to amend the agenda. Commissioner Meares seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and approved by a unanimous vote.

The following items were presented:

Item 1. Request the Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking for establishing traffic and parking regulations prior to reopening Columbus Avenue between Church Street South and South Orange Street. Approval recommended.

Douglas Hausladen presented the technical report. Commissioner Walker moved to approve the item. Commissioner Meares seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and approved by a unanimous vote.

Items 2, 3 and 4. were presented together:

Item 2. Request of Eli Sabin, Alder, Ward 1, for establishing a westbound BIKE LANE on Chapel Street from Temple Street to College Street. Approval recommended.

Item 3. Request of Eli Sabin, Alder, Ward 1, for establishing a westbound CONTRA-FLOW BIKE LANE on Wall Street from College Street to Orange Street. Approval recommended.

Item 4. Request of Eli Sabin, Alder, Ward 1, for establishing a northbound BIKE LANE on York Street from Elm Street to Grove Street. Approval recommended.

Douglas Hausladen presented the technical reports. Commissioner Walker moved to approve the items. Commissioner Meares seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and approved by a unanimous vote.

Item 5. Request of the Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking for parking controls in areas less than one block in length as indicated below be approved.

A. Establish RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED parking spaces.

1. In front of 44 Glen Road..... 1 space
2. In front of 81 Livingston Street..... 1 space
3. In front of 138 Lombard Street..... 1 space
4. In front of 392 Shelton Avenue..... 1 space

B. Rescind RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED parking spaces.

1. In front of 47 Elizabeth Street..... 1 space
2. In front of 3 Loomis Place..... 1 space

Approval of A. and B. is recommended.

Douglas Hausladen presented the technical reports. Commissioner Walker moved to approve the items. Commissioner Meares seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and approved by a unanimous vote.

There being no further business of the Traffic Authority, the meeting was adjourned at 6:21PM.
