

TRAFFIC AUTHORITY MINUTES
JUNE, 2020

The Traffic Authority of the City of New Haven, duly warned, met in Chambers, One Union Avenue, New Haven, Connecticut on June 9th, 2020.

PRESENT (via Zoom): Commissioners: Anthony Dawson, President, Isaias Miranda, Evelise Ribeiro, Gregory Smith and Donald Walker.

The meeting was called to order at 6:02 PM, Commissioner Dawson presiding.

The minutes of the February 11th, 2020 meeting were approved.

The following items were presented:

Item 1. Request of Paola Acosta, Alder, Ward 14, for establishing TWO HOUR PARKING 8AM-7PM, MONDAY-SATURDAY regulation on both sides of Pine Street from Atwater Street to Clinton Avenue. Approval recommended.

Douglas Hausladen presented the technical report. Commissioner Ribeiro moved to approve the item. Commissioner Walker seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and approved by a unanimous vote.

Item 2. Request of the Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking for parking controls in areas less than one block in length as indicated below be approved.

A. Establish RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED parking spaces.

- 1. In front of 77 Ashland Place..... 1 space
- 2. In front of 60 East Pearl Street..... 1 space
- 3. In front of 79 Main Street..... 1 space
- 4. In front of 52 Elizabeth Ann Drive..... 1 space
- 5. In front of 79 Pine Street..... 3 spaces
- 6. In front of 2 Strong Street..... 1 space
- 7. In front of 29 Wellington Rd..... 1 space
- 8. In front of 504 Woodward Avenue..... 1 space

B. Rescind RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED parking spaces.

- 1. In front of 327 Greenwich Avenue..... 1 space

Approval of A. and B. is recommended.

Douglas Hausladen presented the technical report. Commissioner Ribeiro moved to approve the amended item. Commissioner Miranda seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and approved by a unanimous vote.

C. Establish LOADING ZONE Regulation.

- 1. On the east side of York Street at the first two meter spaces north of the Wall Street walkway. (40 feet.) Request of Yale University.

Approval of C. is recommended.

Douglas Hausladen presented the technical report. Commissioner Ribeiro moved to approve the amended item. Commissioner Miranda seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and approved by a unanimous vote.

There being no further business of the Traffic Authority, the meeting was adjourned at 6:10 PM.
