

Excavation & Sidewalk Permit Requirements

Effective immediately, all applicants applying for Excavation & Sidewalk Permits are required to bring the following information **at the time of application**:

- 1. An Excavation & Sidewalk Permit Application filled out completely.
 - > Letters containing all the information will no longer be accepted in place of the application!
- 2. Include a plan showing the work you are doing. The following information must be included in the plan:
 - Cross Streets must be visible and labeled
 - The dimensions of work being done in Street & Sidewalk *If doing work in both the Street and Sidewalk the dimensions for each must be separate.
 - Plan must show what work is being done (i.e., Water Main/Lateral work, Electrical, installing piping, etc.) Be as detailed as possible!
- 3. Include a Traffic Plan:
 - > The traffic plan must show a legend for all symbols being used.
 - > As well as road and pedestrian plan when blocking both street and sidewalk
 - Show the position of all traffic control devices required, spacing of such devices and other critical dimensions such as width of pedestrian walkways, travel lanes, work area, etc.
- 4. When excavating in street for a Utility Company, you must provide a letter from them stating that they are *responsible for permanent pavement restoration*.

*If this letter is not available at the time of application, a Permanent Patch Fee will be charged: Local Road Fee - \$1,000 per 85 Sq. Ft.

Collector Road Fee - \$1500 per 85 Sq. Ft.

Applications with missing documentation will NOT be accepted!

Excavation/Sidewalk Permits Are Not Available Same Day. *Standard Review Requires A Minimum Of (1) One Week.
