## **BACKGROUND**

Lower Ct. River Valley Council of Governments (LCRVCG) has been designated the fiscal administrator for Region 2 (30 municipalities located within DEMHS Region 2, including the City of New Haven) for the Federal Fiscal Year 2020 SHSGP for the benefit of municipalities in DEMHS Region 2. These funds are for the purpose of expanding regional use of equipment, planning and participation in region/state wide exercises.

In this year's allocation there is \$1,654,801 for seven set aside projects (Including: Medical Preparation and Response, Citizen Corps, Enhancing Cyber Security and more) and \$382,156.80 targeted for the 30 municipalities in DEMHS Region 2 and disbursed in accordance with Region 2 approved bylaws.

Since there is no direct funding to the City of New Haven and therefore no matching amounts, New Haven benefits, as do all municipalities, from regional projects that benefit everyone.
